


## Mini-Retreats For Meaningful Living: Catechists - God's Call To Speak About Our Faith

## Paul, Apostle To Christ



When we experience God's love we come to understand in a powerful way that we are in fact "lovable" (23 min.). *Segment II: Breath of God* - The only way we are able to live a life of faith full of love, peace, joy, and the power of the Holy Spirit is by the Holy Spirit. Rediscover Pentecost and the transforming power of the Holy Spirit (24 min.). *Segment III: Baptism in the Holy Spirit* - Discover what Baptism in the Holy Spirit is all about (28 min.). *Segment IV: The Spirit and Our Lady* - The Blessed Virgin, from the moment of her conception, was overshadowed by the Holy Spirit. If we have the courage, as Mary did, to say yes to God's Spirit and surrender our will to His, we too will experience the power of the Most High overshadowing us (28 min.).
