Rev. James Mallon speaks with a new guest on each of eleven half-hour episodes, showcasing the importance of grandparents in the faith lives of their children and grandchildren. Saints relating to grandparents are also included in each segment. **Disc I** - Kelly Ann shares about her grandfather's witness of personal holiness through prayer, participation in Mass, offering his sufferings, and even in sailing. Dennis moved from the being a lukewarm Christian to becoming a missionary disciple, influenced by the authentic faith of his grandparents who even paid for a conference that offered Dennis an encounter with Christ and initiated his conversion. Katie shares how her grandparents filled in the gaps when her parents were unable to adequately care for her and how the Holy Spirit inspired them to know just how and when to evangelize in a way that did not cause her to rebel. **Disc II** - Fr. Bob shares the ways that his grandparents inspired him to live out his vocation and daily answer the call more fully. Maria recalls fondly the Christmas play tradition her grandmother inspired in their family and the ways that her grandmother inspired her by lived faith and natural conversation with God throughout her days. **Disc III** - Anne Marie spent a week each summer with her grandmother and learned from her consistent sincere faith that always modeled hospitality, joy, stewardship, and dependence on prayer. Craig may have not remained in the Catholic church had it not been for the gentle guidance of his grandparents and their everyday living of Catholic practices of service, humility, and unconditional forgiveness. Three children in the Youchesyn family live near their grandparents and have developed a close relationship with them. In all the goodness that the grandparents shared with family, friends, and strangers, it is obvious to the grandchildren that Jesus is the "main thing" in their lives. **Disc IV** - Maria, who was raised by her grandparents, believes her grandparents really formed her to be the person she is today by watching their example of living out their marriage vocation, relying on God and Mary, and showing Maria how to be a good homemaker in preparation for her own adult years. Clare belongs to a large close-knit family seeped in faith and family tradition, rooted in morals, and guided and inspired by grandparents who make the Eucharist the center of their lives and the lives of their family.

Saint Paul exhorts the Christians at Philippi to have the mind of Christ. This series opens up the meaning of that exhortation as it explores the power and joy of life in Jesus Christ and the partnership to which we are called in sharing the Gospel. **Paul and the Philippians** - Paul begins redirecting Greek ideals in light of Christ in order to root the Philippians' identity first and foremost in Jesus Christ. **Partnership in the Gospel** - Saint Paul and the Philippians are partners in the work of the Gospel. We are invited to enter into this partnership with such abandonment to God's will that we can rejoice in all circumstances. **Friendship in Christ** - Paul emphasizes the importance of having the mind of Christ in order to live out the Christian ideal of friendship: loving God and neighbor. Paul calls the Philippians to the virtue of humility which allows us to look first to the interests of others. **The Mind of Christ** - Saint Paul's great hymn to Christ in Philippians 2:6-11 reminds us that if we will have the mind of Christ and pursue his humble obedience, we will also experience the glory of his exaltation. **Imitatio Christi** - Using Old Testament sacrificial language, Paul exhorts us to press on and gain Christ by giving up everything, thus sharing in his Cross and Resurrection. **All Things in Christ** - Saint Paul closes his letter by calling us to discipleship by our acts of virtue, sacrificial love, and abiding joy in order to create a pleasing aroma to God and a witness to bring others into the citizenship of Heaven.
