Besides drawing a crowd for fun and laughter, it can be used to help brainstorm or reflect upon some of the following ideas: "Whose face could you see there?" "If that was your face, what gifts would you bring to the vocation?" "What qualities would you like to see in the face of that priest-to-be?"
